TOBY KEITH: "When I saw them live, they were more than I could have expected and I signed them on the spot."

Such was his description of FLYNNVILLE TRAIN, who signed to his management team as well as his Show Dog label. The deal resulted in two charted singles on the Billboard chart and a number 22 spot on the "Heatseeker" Billboard chart.

Labeled by their fans as "Americas' band," FLYNNVILLE TRAIN's music spans multiple genres and hooks fans of all ages. At home or abroad, the band electrifies audiences with their music and live stage show "We love performing for international audiences – they really get what we are about, and the love and appreciation that comes back to us from them is amazing." FLYNNVILLE TRAIN stole the show at the 24th Craponne Festival in France in 2011, whipping a crowd of 12,000 into an all-out frenzy. The same happened at the 28th Mragowo Festival in Poland in 2012. The band returned to France in August 2013 to perform at the 13th French Riviera Country Music Festival and were the sensation of the event. Additionally they played the most prestigious event in Europe, covered by National Swiss Television and Radio – the 25th Country Night, Gstaad, Switzerland in September 2013. They performed along with GRECHEN WILLSON, LEANN RIMES and VINCE GILL AND THE TIME JUMPERS. The band remarked "It is such an honor for us to be sharing the stage with these amazing artists that we admire and respect. It's one of our dreams come true."

In 2013, FLYNNVILLE TRAIN signed with AMP ENTERTAINMENT for label and marketing representation and their international success has now led to a licensing deal with AGR-TELEVISION RECORDS in Germany, where they signed a licensing deal for the their new cd "Back On Track." The Eurpean cd was released during their visit to Switzerland in September 2013. The US release of "Back On Track" took place on April 18, 2014 in the band's home state to a packed house at Hoosier Park Racing and Casino in Anderson, Indiana. Later that summer, FLYNNVILLE TRAIN returned to Europe to perform at the prestigious Alltech Music Festival in Caan, France, along with a stop at Disneyland Paris. FLYNNVILLE TRAIN will once again travel to Europe in the summer of 2015.

It is also seldom that such a unique and powerful live sound can be captured in the studio from three musicians and a lead singer. But with a band as talented as this, they proved it was possible, as evidenced by their two previous albums. January 2013 saw them back in the studio to finish off their current album with legendary Richard Young of The Kentucky Headhunters as Producer. Most of their songs are recorded "live" in the studio like the 60's and early 70's, hence the "real" sound that they create.

FLYNNVILLE TRAIN is an irresistible, powerful, hard driving combination of Southern rock and country, with heart-stopping guitar riffs and nostalgic vocals as gritty as a long dirt road. From start

to finish, their unique sound captivates the listener, whether live or on CD, and their sound and style has no boundaries.

Formed by brothers Brian and Brent Flynn, the band comprises Brian Flynn on lead vocals, Brent Flynn on lead guitar and harmony vocals (a natural blend unique to brothers). Tommy Bales on drums has been with the band for over thirteen years. Tommy, a country boy from Northern Indiana, grew up in a house filled with music — His father was a professional drummer also. Tommy was voted Number One most up-and-coming drummer in Modern Drummer magazine in 2009. Joseph Shreve on bass, another hard working guy from a small town, adds his own flavor to the band's sound drawing from his extensive musical background including classical, country, rock and bluegrass. Together, they form a band of brothers in music, with each bringing something unique to the sound that comprises FLYNNVILLE TRAIN.

The Flynn brothers, Brian and Brent, raised by hard working parents in a Christian family of farmers and factory workers in Indiana, can totally relate to the working man. Both brothers inherited their natural gift of music. They grew up listening to their father and uncles' band. In addition to being the lead vocalist, Brian is also an accomplished drummer. Brent received his first guitar when he was 5 years old, but is able to play any stringed instrument. His breath-taking guitar riffs and fills are delivered in a style all his own.

Brian and Brent Flynn state: "Now we are able to carve our own destiny, which we never could before. We have built a team of strong in-house people who believe in us and will be part of our extended family. We are all good and honest people who are prepared to work hard. Our goal is to take our music to the world and no matter where we perform, the key is that we give everyone a great time. We want to be remembered wherever we play."
