ABOUT JUDY PASTER:

Judy Paster is a Nashville-based, Pennsylvania-raised Americana country artist who infuses new life into the timeless roots music genre. Known for her distinctive style and powerful spirit, Paster channels the essence of 70s singer-songwriters while bringing a fresh, contemporary edge to her sound. Her debut as a trio brings together two Grammy-winning musicians from The Time Jumpers Band, Joe Spivey and Brad Albin, combining acoustic guitar, upright bass, and fiddle to create a lush, emotive backdrop for her stunning songs that offer solace in the midst of life’s chaos.

Paster first gained national attention with her self-titled debut EP, *Judy Paster*, which caught the eye of *Billboard* and quickly labeled her as an artist “truly on the rise.” Soon after, she made the bold move to Nashville, where she carved out a niche in the city’s dynamic singer/songwriter community, gaining local airplay and critical acclaim.

Since relocating to Music City, Paster has earned multiple prestigious accolades, including the coveted 2021 Josie Music Award for Folk/Americana Artist of the Year and a Canadian Covenant Award (the Canadian equivalent of the Dove Award) for co-writing the Jazz Blues Song of the Year. A three-time GMA Covenant Award nominee, she has recorded with Southern Gospel legends like the Gaithers and contributed to a wide variety of musical projects, from her own releases to TV and film work. One of her songs, “Christmas Crush,” co-written with Bill DiLuigi and Corey Lee Barker, was featured in the Lifetime TV movie, *The Holiday Exchange*.

Most recently, Paster signed with Synapse Publishing & Entertainment to join forces with three other female country artists/songwriters for *Women Behind the Lyrics*, a reality TV series and national tour set to kick off in October 2025. Filming is already underway in Nashville.

With five albums to her name—including *Judy Paster*, *Stronger*, *Rubies*, *Rocks & Stones*, *Like Stardust*, and *Road To The Sun*—Paster continues to prove herself as a dynamic force in the Americana and country music scene. Her songs resonate with authenticity, power, and grace, cementing her as a standout artist whose career is only just beginning.

Carson Hill is known for her fiery voice, expressive songwriting, and impressive guitar skills. Hailing from North Carolina, the rising star began captivating audiences at a young age before moving to Nashville at 18 to pursue her musical dreams. Whether performing at iconic venues like the Bluebird Café or North Carolina’s Double Door Inn, Carson commands the stage with a magnetic presence.
