Road To The Sun is a collaboration with Symphonic Distribution and is a powerful reflection of Paster's life. It was produced by industry veterans Joe Spivey and Shawn Byrne, recorded at Great Hill Productions in Nashville, and was mixed and mastered by Jeff Baggett and Sean Gasaway. The project is already creating a buzz among industry professionals and music fans alike. The title track was featured on 89.5 WMOT Roots Radio - both on *The Local Brew* and at their *Finally Friday* show held at renowned Nashville music venue 3rd & Lindsley. She was also featured on Radio SoBro's *NuMu Friday* and was one of *Pop Blitz Magazine's New Music Friday* picks.

Paster is known for blending musical genres and *Road To The Sun* is no exception. She flawlessly intertwines the favorite sounds of country, Americana, and folk rock music to create a unique sound and a captivating and endearing project that will resonate with music lovers spanning multiple genres and generations. The production is stellar throughout this collection. It boasts a retro vibe with a rootsy yet culturally important feel.

"My album, 'Road To The Sun,' is a direct imprint of my life, where it started in the suburbs of Philadelphia and van life in California, to where I am now in Nashville, TN! My goal with my artistry is to deliver a burst of light through my songs into people's hearts and souls! ABOUT JUDY PASTER:

Pennsylvania-raised country Americana artist Judy Paster revitalizes the timeless roots music genre with her captivating sound. Known for her bold spirit and distinctive style, Paster blends the classic sensibilities of 70s singer / songwriters with a modern twist, drawing comparisons to the likes of Emmylou Harris and Kacey Musgraves. Her music embodies the truth-seeking, bohemian ethos of folk storytelling, Country, and Americana, reminding listeners of the lasting power and relevance of these genres.

Paster is a storyteller at heart – each of her songs weaves vivid landscapes of life's challenges and triumphs, anchored by a thread of honesty and light. Her sound cuts through the noise of everyday life, offering serenity and introspection through her powerfully evocative lyrics.

She first garnered attention in *Billboard* with her rootsy debut EP, *Judy Paster*, which earned praise for marking her as an artist "truly on the rise." Soon after, she moved to Nashville, where she began making waves in the local music scene, earning airplay and carving out her unique niche within the city's vibrant singer / songwriter community.

Since her move to Music City, Paster has achieved significant milestones, including several music awards including the 2021 Josie Music Award for Folk/ Americana Artist of the Year, a Canadian Covenant Award (the Canadian equivalent of America's Dove) for co-writing the Jazz Blues Song of the Year, and multiple GMA (Gospel Music Association) Covenant Award nominations. She has also recorded with Southern Gospel icons, the Gaithers.

Paster's most recent project, a trio debut, showcases her collaboration with two Grammy-winning musicians from The Time Jumpers, blending acoustic guitar, upright bass, and fiddle to create a rich, dynamic soundscape. Known for her songwriting prowess, she has penned tunes for both independent artists and film and TV. Her song "Christmas Crush" (co-written with Bill DiLuigi and Corey Lee Barker) was featured in the 2024 Lifetime TV movie *The Holiday Exchange*. Additionally, Paster has performed at prominent venues and festivals across the southeastern U.S.

Having appeared on WSM's Opry Nashville Radio, Paster has earned worldwide airplay on Americana and country radio stations. She signed a distribution deal with Symphonic Distribution and another with Synapse Publishing & Entertainment. Additionally, she will be one of four featured female country artists/ songwriters touring the country together as part of a groundbreaking new reality TV series, *Women Behind the Lyrics*. The show is set to begin later this year.

Since the release of her debut EP *Judy Paster* and *Road To The Sun*, Paster has released three other albums—*Stronger*, *Rubies*, *Rocks & Stones*, and *Like Stardust*—along with several singles. Her music videos, including "Chop Wood Carry Water" and her latest, "With A Kiss," can be seen on The Heartland Network, Country Road TV, TCN (The Country Network), The Family Channel, and other platforms worldwide.



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
